



## LILLIAN EVE BENEVOLENT FUND

The Benevolent Fund is a registered charity and is independent separate from the force and the federation. The committee review all applications and is made up of serving police officers, representing the Area Commands and Departments, and retired officers.

- Members pay a nominal fee of **£2 per payday**
- Expenses are paid for visits to convalescent homes of £30 per week.
- The fund owns a holiday home in the Lake District which is granted to deserving cases free of charge.
- Help has been given to officers recovering from traumatic incidents at work or at home such as needle/stick injuries, violence, assaults etc.



- Members with children with disabilities have received computers, televisions and specialist transport adaptations. Grants have been given to alter homes, build ramps and assist with specialist equipment for members health needs.
- The fund pays for all wreaths and flowers when officers pass away, either in service or when retired.
- We exist to help officers and continually receive applications from officers who aren't members which is frustrating as they must be declined.
- Anyone joining will be eligible to access the fund after the first deduction from their pay.
